International Accreditation & Validation

The ICCHP our proud to announce the validation and accreditation of our courses by the National/International Council of Psychotherapists (NCP/ICP) and the International Association of Counselors and Therapists (IACT). We would like to thank Aloysius Tay for all of his help with these accreditations.





Our practitioner courses have been accredited by the National/International Council of Psychotherapists (NCP/ICP) at Diploma level. Diplomas are accredited individually as practitioner training and the NCP's aim is to maintain and develop professional standards. Diploma training accreditation is offered at two levels for members. Entry level diploma accreditation validates that a training course is the equivalent of an Ofqual Level 5 (DipHD/HND)) with a minimum of 370 Guided Learning Hours (GLH). Also, diploma accreditation for courses rated at Level 6 (BSc) or Level 7 (Masters) with a minimum of 370 Guided Learning Hours (GLH). The Office of Qualifications and Examinations Regulation (Ofqual) regulates

qualifications, examinations and assessments in England.

The ICCHP's Practitioner Certificate in Evidencebased Integrative Clinical Hypnosis (PCHyp) is accredited at Level 5 and the ICCHP's Practitioner Diploma in Evidence-based Integrative Clinical Hypnosis (PDHyp) is accredited at Level 6.

ICCHP graduates in the UK can now join the NCP and those outside the UK can join the ICP. For more information visit: https://www.thencp.org/


ICCHP Classroom Courses Now Available Live-Streamed

It also features an integrated video conferencing system, just like Zoom and other similar applications, but it uses the most secure communications protocols, unlike Zoom and others. It is the same secure system used by the large

online therapy providers and meets government and professional body regulations, so that you can ensure complete client confidentiality.

You can use as much or as little of the functionality and at no cost. It is part of the ICCHP support provided to our graduates in practice.

Dr. Gayathri K. Kumarasuriar is a Psychiatrist currently practicing in Melaka Hospital and Pantai Hospital Ayer Keroh in Malaysia. Dr Gayathri obtained her Postgraduate Membership from the Royal College of Psychiatrists, UK. She has the distinction of being the first trained candidate from the Ministry of Health in Malaysia to have passed the MRCPsych examination. She also has the distinction of being the first Psychiatrist in the Ministry of Health in Malaysia to combine Hypnotherapeutic Techniques with traditional psychotherapy in the management of patients, offering them a more holistic, flexible and eclectic mode of therapy. Her area of interests are Psychoneuroimmunology, Epigenetics and Quantum Consciousness.

Dr Gayathri has been fascinated about the power of the mind since she was 12 years old. She is now part of the Psychiatry Speciality Postgraduate Training Committee and the National Coordinator for the Psychiatry Parallel Pathway Program in the Ministry of Health Malaysia. Having obtained her Essential Skills in Medical Education Certificate from AMEE, Dr Gayathri is involved in the National Curriculum for Postgraduate Training in Psychiatry. A well as being the ICCHP Medical Director, Dr. Gayathri is the programme Director and a senior lecturer with ICCHP Malaysia.

Dr Mohammad bin Abdul Rahman is Associate Professor in Psychiatry with the Faculty of Medicine at Universiti Kuala Lumpur (UniKL), Royal College of Medicine Perak (RCMP) Ipoh and affiliated to NBCC International Malaysia as Trainer for the Mental Health Facilitator Program. Dr Mohammad holds a Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) from Universiti Malaya and Master of Medicine in Psychiatry (M.Med Psychiatry) from Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia.

Throughout the book Sarah presents her own experiences and application of the principles and the exercises, as well as her client's experiences.

He has moved to the Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences, Universiti Malaysia Sarawak (UniMAS) in 1996/97 and started training and services in Organizational Mental Health from 1998-2008. He Joined the Faculty of Medicine, UniKL RCMP in 2008 until now. Dr Mohammad teaches Behavioural Sciences, Psychology and Clinical Psychiatry to medical and nursing students. Apart from conducting programmes and courses in Preventive and Interventional Mental Health, Dr Mohammad is a Programme Director and senior lecturer with ICCHP Malaysia.

New Courses Available Online

The Integrated Performance Enhancement (IPECert) course teaches individuals how to take control of and improve personal performance and well-being, in themselves and in others. This course appeals to three types of individuals: those interested in their own self development; those wanting to establish a lucrative career as a performance enhancement practitioner; and those individuals who currently work to improve the performance and well-being of others, such as personal trainers, coaches, mentors, clinical and non-clinical therapists, holistic practitioners, educators, etc.

The Integrated Stress Reduction (ISRCert) course teaches individuals how to take control of and improve personal physical health and psychological well-being, in themselves and in others. This course appeals to three types of individuals: those interested in their own self development; those wanting to establish a lucrative career as a stress reduction practitioner; and those individuals who currently work to improve the physical and mental well-being of others, such as personal trainers, coaches, mentors, clinical and non-clinical therapists, holistic practitioners, educators, etc.

Students of the PCHyp & PDHyp courses will have already covered the content of these course, so attending would be a refresher, with a specific certificate issued.

The New Integrated Mind Body Health Practitioner (MBHP) Programme

The Integrated Mind Body Health Practitioner (MBHP) programme is a new and unique professional training career pathway offered from the ICCHP. It is a logical evolutionary progression for hypnotherapists to expand and extend their skills and embrace other complementary health practices beyond traditional hypnotherapy.

Graduates who have completed the PDHyp course will be eligible to obtain an MBHP qualification by attending a number of relevantly assigned MBHP master classes, which will be positioned online and in the classroom.

Student Learning Portal Updates

A major change to the student learning portal is that it now has its own dedicated internet domain. You will need to use the following address to access the online course modules through your browser: https://www.icchphypnotherapycourses.com. The https://www.icchp.com/moodle address is no longer used. If you use the old domain address you will be redirected to the new one. Please reset your bookmarks.

Changes to Module 101

The original Certificate course module 101 is now module 200, which is the module all practitioner

students should be using. The current Certificate course module 101 is now a free course module for potential students who want to trial the course. It does not contain any practitioner course resources.

Course Content Updates

Updates to the course content on the learning portal are continuing and you will notice changes taking place. Most of these changes relate to updating of the course content, but there have been some structural changes. New information and updated research is constantly being added in both the theory notes and the practical notes, along with some additional videos and scripts. All of the classroom practice notes for each module have been updated. You will be able to identify the new versions of the notes by their version numbers, v3.20, being the latest.

Classroom lecture video clips, updated course notes and additional learning resources are being added regularly, so it is worthwhile checking back into modules that you have already completed.

Global Search Facility

Remember that there is a Global Search Function available. This is a course wide global search function that will let you search information in all of the courses as well as the discussion forums in which you have access.

Moodle App

You now have a Moodle app available to you, so that you can load the app onto your smartphone or tablet and access your course material any time and anywhere. Just download the Moodle app from your appstore. You will need to use the https://www.icchphypnotherapycourses.com address to access the course through your browsers and Moodle app.

Glossary/Graduate Forums

Don't forget that you can add to the Glossary of Terms. Students and practitioners are encouraged to populate the Glossary. By doing so you can obtain ratings for extra credit towards your course grade and additional credit time towards your CPD requirements.

Also, remember that practitioners can use the graduate forums to share case related information and obtain help and support with presenting conditions. You can also share with each other your learning experiences in practice and what you find is working for you, to help build your practice.

Study/Practice Groups

The ICCHP encourages students to participate in study/practice groups, as those students participating in these groups demonstrate a higher level of knowledge, understanding and practical ability. Group members also support and encourage each other to complete the on-line course modules and get started in practice.

If you want to organise or join a study group then please post a message in the on-line student forums. Study groups can also be used for practice based discussion once you are seeing clients.

Having others to share your practice experience with will help you develop your knowledge and skills as a practitioner.

Remember, if you have, or you are attending study group sessions with each other then please record these by keeping a record of who attended, time spent, topics discussed and techniques practised. You can include this within your learning portfolio and it all counts towards your training hours and Continuing Professional Development (CPD) requirements for the GHR and CNHC. You can also have these validated by submitting for tutor signature.



The OneNote Script application allows you to have all of your scripts from the course with you, either on a phone, tablet or computer. This allows you to be responsive to a client's needs, quickly adapting a session without having to flip through files of paperwork to find an appropriate script. Scripts are already organised into inductions, deepeners, therapeutic interventions, etc.

It is simple to add to any device, you just need Microsoft OneNote which usually comes free with your Microsoft Office suite (word, excel, etc.), or can be downloaded from your App store.
